DRURY LANE THEATER LUNCH TRIP IN JUNE

Join us for a road trip to **Drury Lane Theatre** in Oakbrook Terrace on Thursday, June 23rd for lunch and Neil Simon's classic comedy, **Broadway Bound**. We'll travel by deluxe motor coach to and from the Center to Drury Lane where we'll enjoy lunch that includes salad, a choice of roast sirloin of beef or baked salmon with dill sauce, a selection of garden vegetables, potato or rice, fresh baked bread, dessert, and choice of beverage.

After a leisurely lunch, we'll be treated to the Tony Award nominated, Broadway Bound, a comedy that chronicles Eugene and Stan Jerome's attempts to break into show business as comedy writers in the late 1940's. At the play's conclusion, we'll travel back to the Center. The all inclusive price for transportation, lunch and the play is \$65 per person. While the exact departure time has yet to be determined, we expect to leave the Center mid-morning in order to arrive in time for lunch. We need a minimum of 30 paid reservations to take this trip. 
GENEVA HISTORY CENTER VISIT AND BOX LUNCH

COMMEMORATING MEMORIAL DAY

Geneva Township will continue its tradition of observing Memorial Day, Monday, May 30, by placing ceremonial 3' X 5' American flags at each grave in Geneva Township of those killed in defense of our country. To honor those Geneva Township citizens killed in wartime and whose graves lie somewhere beyond our township, we will once again erect a 23-flag tribute. The tribute will occur on Memorial Day on the plaza immediately in front and west of the Center. At approximately 6:30 a.m. the Fox River-Geneva American Legion Post 75 Color Guard will perform a 21-gun rifle salute followed by the bugle call Taps. The Center will be open from 6:30 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. on Memorial Day for Township residents who wish to observe this moving tribute.
