If you haven't attended a football party at the Center before; don't miss another year. The Center doors will open at 4:30 pm on **Sun-**



AARP Tax Preparation Appointments

Volunteer AARP preparers will once again be at the Center on Tuesday and Thursday each week to help members complete and file their 2015 Federal and IL tax returns. Tax preparation appointments are now available for all dates beginning Tuesday, February 9. AARP volunteers are trained and tested in current tax law using materials from the IRS. They can complete most tax forms including 1040EZ, 1040Å, and 1040 with schedules. However, please see a professional tax preparer for complicated returns. When you come for your appointment, please bring a photo ID (driver's license, State ID, passport), social security card or Individual Taxpayer Identification notice with the full number, a copy of last year's tax return, all forms W-2 and 1099, and any other information specific to your tax situation. For a list of tax forms that can be completed by the AARP preparers, please contact the Center. There is no cost for this service. Appointments are required. Call 630/232-3602 to make an appointment.
