Shuffleboard Tournament

If you haven't taken advantage of the Center's table shuffleboard game located on the porch, stop in and give it a whirl. The 1st Shuffleboard Tournament has been scheduled for Friday, January 13 starting at 12:45pm. Table shuffleboard (also known as American shuffleboard, indoor shuffleboard, slingers, shufflepuck, and quoits) is a game in which players push weighted pucks down a long and smooth table into a scoring area at the opposite end of the table. Shooting is performed with the hand directly, as opposed to deck shuffleboard's use of cue sticks. Each end of the table is divided into three scoring sections by straight lines across the width of the table. Players take turns sliding, or "shuffling," the weights to the opposite end of the board, trying to score points, bump opposing pucks off the board, or protect their own pucks from bump-offs. Points are scored by getting a weight to stop in one of the numbered scoring areas. Teams of two will be formed by a random draw before the start of the tournament. Rules for the game will also be reviewed. Call the Center at 630/232-3602 if you'd like to participate. No prior experience is necessary! If you'd like, sign up for the Friday lunch that's served beginning at 11:30.

AARP Tax Preparation

Volunteer AARP preparers will once again be at the Center on Tuesday and Thursday

each week to help members complete and file their 2016 Federal and IL tax returns. Tax preparation appointments are now available for all



dates beginning Tuesday, February 7. AARP volunteers are trained and tested in current tax law using materials from the IRS. They can complete most tax forms including 1040EZ, 1040A, and 1040 with schedules. However, please see a professional tax preparer for complicated returns. A photo ID (driver's license, State ID, passport), social security card or Individual Taxpayer Identification notice with the full number, a copy of last year's tax return, all forms W-2 and 1099, and any other information specific to your tax situation must be presented at your appointment. There is no cost for this service. However, appointments are required. Call 630/232-3602 to make an appointment.

The File of Life program is FREE to members of the Center. Preprinted forms are provided to record vital medical and health information that would greatly assist emergency first responders in the event of an emergency. Current prescriptions, doctor's name and phone number, allergies, and emergency contacts are examples of information included on the File of Life form. The completed form is placed in the provided plastic sleeve and slipped over the car visor. A smaller duplicate form can be carried in a purse or wallet. Program materials are available in the Center office; stop in and pick one up.


Football Party at the Center
