South Texas Birding Presentation

The Coastal Bend of Texas has great diversity and numbers of birds due to its location. Eastern habitats meet with drier western habitats. Tropical areas blend into subtropical and temperate areas, the beach meets brushy rangeland, rivers and estuaries meet barrier islands, and flyways converge at the curve of the bend. Because of the proximity of the diverse habitats and the Gulf of Mexico, the area attracts many resident, migrant and accidental birds. On Wednesday, June 14 at 10:00am Center member, Cliff Tebeau, will give a presentation on the birds that populate that part of Texas. Cliff and his wife, Mary, spend winters there.
