In 1912, Nabisco had a new idea for a cookie—two chocolate disks

with a creme filling in between. The first Oreo cookie looked very similar to the Oreo cookie of today, with only a slight difference in the design of the chocolate disks. The current design, however, has been around since 1952. Over 362 billion Oreo cookies have been sold since it was first introduced in 1912, making it the best-selling

Elgin History Museum and Lunch

On Wednesday, August 21 a trip is planned to visit The Elgin History Museum. It's housed in an 1856 landmark building known as *Old Main* that was once part of the Elgin Academy campus. The building was designed in the Greek Revival style. Through permanent and changing exhibits, the museum brings to life Elgin's rich heritage. Permanent exhibits include Elgin National Watch Company, Elgin Manufacturing, Elgin Road Race memorabilia, Elgin Architecture, and Elgin: From River to Rails. The total inclusive cost of \$30 covers round-trip coach bus transportation, admission to the museum, and lunch at Houlihan's in Geneva. We will depart the Center at 10:30 am for the trip to Elgin. After our tour, our bus will head for Houlihan's in Geneva for lunch. After lunch, we'll return to the Center. Payment for this trip must be made no later than Wednesday, Aug. 14.

she barely speaks a word. Aside from one muffled request for water and a hushed discussion with her musical director, there's not a peep out of her. Instead, she focuses her concentration wholly on the spirit of the gospel music she came to perform during the film's historic two-day shoot, which took place in January 1972 at the New Temple Baptist Mission church in Los Angeles.

AUGUST 23 TOLKIEN (2019) Rated PG-13 (1:52 Hours)

Tolkien explores the formative years of the orphaned author, J.R.R. Tolkien, as he finds friendship, love and artistic inspiration among a group of fellow outcasts at school. This takes him into the outbreak of World War I, which threatens to tear the "fellowship" apart. These experiences would inspire Tolkien to write his famous Middle-Earth novels.

AUGUST 30 A DOG'S JOURNEY (2019) Rated PG (1:48 Hours) Starring Josh Gad, Dennis Quaid

Bailey (voiced again by Josh Gad) is living the good life on the Michigan farm of his "boy," Ethan (Dennis Quaid) and Ethan's wife Hannah (Marg Helgenberger). He even has a new playmate: Ethan and Hannah's baby granddaughter, CJ. The problem is that CJ's mom, Gloria (Betty Gilpin), decides to take CJ away. As Bailey's soul prepares to leave this life for a new one, he makes a promise to Ethan to find CJ and protect her at any cost.
