## The Great Chicago Fire: A Phoenix from the Ashes

On Wednesday, February 26 @ 1:00pm, Chicago actor Terry Lynch visits the Center to present an interactive performance with a first-person portrayal of Patrick O'Leary. Terry has done historical portrayals for over 20 years. During two days in October 1871, the city of Chicago was engulfed in flames, resulting in the destruction of thousands of buildings and the loss of approximately 300 lives. In this program, Patrick O'Leary discusses the different theories surrounding the fire's origin and its aftermath. Was Catherine O'Leary, the Irish immigrant and Patrick's wife, responsible for the blaze, or was it caused by other factors? Despite the catastrophe, the city quickly recovered as the rebuilding process ushered in a period of unprecedented economic growth and population expansion. # **Tax Preparation Appointments**

Members may now make AARP tax preparation appointments for Tuesday or Thursday each week at the Center beginning Tuesday, February 4, 2025. Volunteer AARP income tax preparers will assist you in completing your 2024 Federal and IL tax returns. All returns are electronically filed. Most tax forms including 1040EZ, 1040A, and 1040 with schedules can be completed. A photo ID (driver's license, State ID, passport), social security card or Individual Taxpayer Identification notice, a copy of last year's tax returns, all income documents like W2's and 1099's, brokerage statements, and any other tax information specific to your situation must be presented at your appointment. A handout of essential documents is available in the Center office. There is no charge for this service. However, appointments are required. Call the Center (630/232-3602) soon to schedule your preferred appointment date and time.
